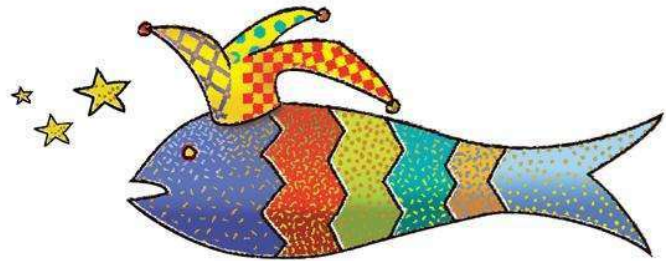


Liverpool International Theatre Festival

Distance Travelled: 6,600 km

Play: Break the Silence

A physical theatre exploration of silence, connection and the human need to be heard.

POLAND - Scream Theatre - Maszewo

Play: Hey You

An intimate, energetic exploration of growing up, connection and finding your place.

NETHERLANDS – Hoosh Theater - Amsterdam

A poetic physical theatre piece about leaving home, independence and taking the first step.
